İLÇEMİZ HÜYÜK





Hüyük is a town of Konya city. It's in the middle west of Anatolia, Hüyük is on the silk road and there are 2 natural spring water areas in Hüyük town which are open for tourists and host a lot of tourists from Turkey. Its population is around 4000.



- Hüyük's 350 km to capital city Ankara, and about 300 km to Antalya city.
- Since Turkey is a bridge between a lot of civilizations Hüyük has also a lot of historical sights from Hitites, Byzantines, Otoman Empire.













Hüyük Provincial National Education Directorate decides on the needs of schools and tries to supply them by asking some official authorities such as municipality, sub-governors.



- There are 13 people working in its body, but it addresses to a large amount for education staff; students, 200 teachers, cleaners at schools, civil servants etc.
- So our institution serves for teachers organising some seminars, conferences and for students arranging some social activities.
- It supports Adult Education, Vocational Education Centres too.





Fishing

- There is a lake near Hüyük town, which is the third biggest lake of Turkey
- A lot of fishes could be found in this lake
- there are 2 fish factories for exporting fish ready of filet.





- In Hüyük agriculture is very popular with retired people. Most people have their own farms, and people can produce most of their food such as onions, potatoes, tomatoes, strawberries, cherries, treenuts etc.



- Especially these years most farmers export their products such as strawberries, treenuts, cherries to other cities or countries.

- A solution for unemployment has been found.



EDUCATION OF UNEMPLOYED PEOPLE

Adult Education Centres which are bound to Town National Education directorates offer a lot of courses for unemployed people.

Adult Education Centres have courses together with Labour Offices for workers, most of them are for 6 months and they get certificates and they are paid their own money too.

For example: ICT, farming course for organic strawberry growing...
